CONTINGENT EQUIPMENT

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTINGENT LEADER TO ENSURE THAT PARTICIPANTS IN THEIR CARE ARE PROVIDED AN APPROPRIATE LIST OF PERSONAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED.

THE EVENT ORGANISERS WILL PROVIDE TOILET/WASH FACILITIES AND SHELTER FOR ACTIVITIES WHERE APPROPRIATE.

PLEASE INFORM PARTICIPANTS (INCLUDING LEADERS) THAT UNIFORM AND NECKERS MUST BE WORN DURING THE EVENT (UNLESS REMOVED FOR ACTIVITY SAFETY REASONS).
