



## **West Yorkshire Unit 22nd World Scout Jamboree Information For Prospective Members of The Adult Leadership Team**

The 22nd World Scout Jamboree will be held in Sweden in 2011. The theme for the Jamboree is Simply Scouting. In fact, the 22nd World Scout Jamboree Sweden 2011 is **Simply Scouting!**

### ***... So what does this mean??***

It is the answer to every question: What will the Jamboree experience be like? How will I make friends with Scouts from all over the world? How can we learn about global development? How is this all possible? Answer: Simply Scouting!!

We like to think that this is the feeling you will get onsite, wherever you are. This is the experience of Scouting in all its variety. This is a fantastic quality programme of activities for all. This is a modern approach to tackling today's issues in society. This is our Scout Method, our values, our way of working. Simply Scouting - throughout the camp and in every moment of daily life, Scouts will develop new skills and share their knowledge and experiences whilst working towards greater international understanding. Doing what we love best: Simply Scouting!

Within the theme of "Simply Scouting", there are 3 important concepts that will be present in every aspect of the Jamboree:

### ***Meetings***

22WSJ Sweden will encourage meetings between those from different cultures, religions, countries and contingents. Participants will get to know those who live outside of their own local community and find that strangers can become friends. Meetings will take place everywhere, from module activities to subcamp life, from small camp fires to huge arena events. All aspects of the camp will encourage meetings: the schedule, the programme and even the site design!!

### ***Nature***

22WSJ Sweden will be close to nature, in fact we will live in the middle of nature for 2 weeks, in an immense field surrounded by trees and woodlands. The Jamboree Programme will use the natural environment as a learning tool, demonstrating both its vulnerability and what individuals can do to better protect the world we live in.

### ***Solidarity***

22WSJ Sweden will encourage solidarity between Scouts of all ages, and promote the unity between Scout Organisations from around the world. It will also help us see that we share a common responsibility to our world and to each other. The Jamboree will promote respect for other people, emphasising equal rights and peace and at the Jamboree itself, all are equal, independent of any personal characteristics or background.

The following guidelines are offered to outline potential requirements for those wishing to take on a leadership role. Support and development, where required, will be offered by the County Team.

- We are looking for a blend of positive experience – male, female, young and old.
- You must be adaptable and able to work well with others as part of a team.
- You should have experience, or at the very least show a clear understanding of working with the age group concerned.
- **Camping and outdoor cooking skills will be essential** as the Unit will be responsible for their own catering and camping area on the Jamboree site. We want all the leaders and participants to enjoy the event in a healthy and safe environment.
- It is essential that we have a fit and healthy leadership team. Jamborees are a great experience and very rewarding but it will involve long hours and will be physically and mentally exhausting. Remember the Jamboree experience could last up to three weeks by accounting for the pre-Jamboree event, Jamboree proper and Home Hospitality. The Jamboree site will also cover a very large area.
- Prior to the Jamboree you must be prepared to devote time, energy and enthusiasm to weekend training camps and fundraising.
- Following the Jamboree it is expected that you will develop post event initiatives to ensure Group and District investments are maximised and to ensure, wherever possible, contingent members remain actively involved in Scouting after the Jamboree.
