

The Roger Williams Challenge **In Memory of Roger Williams**



Roger Williams was County Commissioner for West Yorkshire. Last Summer he lost his life whilst touring Norway. Roger did a great deal to promote Scouting in West Yorkshire both as County Commissioner and Assistant County Commissioner (Scouts) before that. This challenge is designed to ;

- Promote the camp site and activity centres around West Yorkshire
- Be flexible enough to be achievable by members from any section
- Give a focus for developing an outdoor emphasis to the section programme

What is the challenge ?

You are challenged to visit a selection of West Yorkshire activity centres or campsites and carry out an activity there. The activity can be something which you organise yourself or something which is offered by the activity centre which you are visiting. In order to achieve the challenge certificates members should complete the following within a 12 month period.

Flexibility in the challenge.

The degree of difficulty involved in the challenge can be set by you according to the type of group undertaking the challenge. For example - An explorer unit may try to complete the challenge as a weekend event travelling between centres on bikes or by undertaking a wide game using public transport. A fellowship may run a series of evening social events at different places whilst a Beaver colony might try to hold a series of picnics over the summer. The way you decide to achieve the challenge is completely flexible and should be used to enhance your programme for your section.
